

HAZARD/ ACTIVITY	PRECAUTION	RISK
Candy Floss machine usage.	PAT test done. Only trained members of staff to use candy floss maker, no audience contact. Heater part of machine to be avoided.	Low, PAT test passed and staff training given.
Audience member eating candy floss	Gloves to be worn by presenter when preparing candy floss. Parent/ guardian of child asked to make sure they can eat it.	Low, candy floss is only made from sugar and precautions will be taken for food safety.
Two part polyurethane foam demo	Gloves and safety goggles to be worn by presenter, no audience contact. HSDS and manufacturer safety catalogues acquired. Safest and easiest way of disposing of ingredients is to make them into foam. Bucket of sand to be present in theatre, to be used in case of spillages. Presenters to get fresh air after each show. Demo to be done on newspaper. Full staff training given.	Low, PPE to be worn and training given to presenters.
Volunteers skipping	Skipping to be done on ground in front of stage, away from other props. Front row of theatre not to be used.	Low, skipping done away from potential hazards.
Volunteers eating sweets.	Only wrapped sweets or candy floss prepared as above to be given out. Parents/ guardians of children asked before giving volunteers sweets, to check for allergies.	Low, sweets not to be handled by presenter and only given out to people not allergic to them.
