Strategic initiative

As part of the programme, each participant will have an opportunity to develop and implement a project (a strategic initiative) that will support them to practise strategic leadership. This project idea will be finalised and approved by your sponsor in July and work on this will start in August 2021. Initiatives should not just be an immediate technical or operational problem to solve. Instead, it should be something genuinely strategic for your organisation. It should be a project that has longer-term impact (beyond the timetable for this programme) and should support your own personal development and understanding of inclusive leadership. An example might be to influence decision making within your organisation about engagement with a specific community that is under-represented in the visiting audience.
